Environmental Policy



Cyrrus comprising Cyrrus Holdings, Cyrrus Projects, Cyrrus Products and Cyrrus Ltd, and hereafter referred to as 'Cyrrus' is an environmentally conscious organisation that recognises the potential impact our activities could have on the environment. Our activities comprise the provision specialist consultancy services to the aviation and renewable energy industries along with technical engineering support for Communication, Navigation and Surveillance systems in Air Traffic Control.

Customer service is an essential part of the environmental process and to ensure this is fulfilled, all employees receive training to ensure awareness and understanding of the environment and its impact of the products or service in which we provide.
